Coach Chuck Knox - We played pretty well in the first half against their best players... we're making a lot of progress, but we still need to play better...If we get more consistent then we can play just about anybody...It was a hard hitting game and a few of our players got hurt...Our offense did a pretty good job in general and I was really impressed with the play of our two quarterbacks...(On the play of Warner)...You saw him cut and I think that he can play in this league...

Eric Lane - I know I'm way down there on the depth chart but I really don't pay attention to those things...It just gives me more incentive to go out there and bust my butt...It's fun to play back home but once you get out there you kind of forget where you're at... (On Bill Ring) Bill's a heck of a player...When he was BYU he always gave 120% and it looks like he's still doing the same thing...That's one player you can always look up to...I won't make any predictions on this year, but we have a good team, a real solid offense and who know where we might end up at the end of the year...

Cullen Bryant - Right now, I'm playing under great circumstances...I'm back with Coach Knox who I think is a real player's coach...I think Warner and I compliment each other like Wendell and I did with the Rams...I'll do more blocking but the defense has to watch out for me because I'm capable of popping up the middle for a few yards now and then... (On Wendell Tyler) Wendell is capable of turning around the 49er offense...He has exceptional skill, a lot of drive and confidence in himself...

Ken McAllister - I've never played any kind of ball here in Candlestick...I got a real kick playing out here in front of my friends and family...I tried to shake things up as much as possible out there today...WE have a great shot to make the playoffs this year just as good as any other team...Our offense is really coming around and I think our defense can hold just about any other offense...We kept the 49ers from scoring a touchdown today and I consider that a real accomplishment...I was not intimidated playing against stars like Montana and Clark...It's just one system against another and today our system was better...

Charle Young - I could have stayed here (with the 49ers) and sat on the bench with all of that money, but I'm just not that kind of a man...My goal now is to stay here now in Seattle for three years and go to the Super Bowl two more times...(About Wendell Tyler) Wendell is a pure athlete, I'm glad he didn't do against us what he has done to other people...

Curt Warner - This team is so loaded with depth I wish we could keep 57 or 58 players... There's a real battle going on for positions and it's going to be interesting to see who wins out...I leave my playing time totally up to the coach, if he wants me to play as little as a quarter, I'll be glad to play just one quarter...I'm a Christian man and I believe the Lord works all things out for the good...You saw us play with enthusiasm today we want to carry that enthusiasm right into the regular season...

Harold Jackson - Coach Knox brought in a system based on the same kind of positive things that you saw with the Rams and the Bills...We have a lot of personnel and we're going to be okay...Getting down to 49 players is going to be tough...(On his 16 years in the league) My college coach used to tell me that I would eventually slow down, but that I would still be as fast as the average receivers in the league...I'm still quick, and I'm using my experience now...Just beating the defensive backs is the key...

Kerry Justin - We see great quarterbacks every week, so we didn't prepare any differently for Joe Montana...I thought he looked especially good the first quarter when they knicked and picked us down the field...Playing against Wendell Tyler is always a challenge because he still has quickness and he should be a big help to the 49ers...

Dave Krieg - (On his sharing playing time with Jim Zorn)...I'm just satisfied to be part of the team effort...I look at myself kind of like Rollie Fingers of the Brewers...Every team needs a good relief quarterback...We're going to have depth this year and we have experience with people like Harold Jackson and Charle Young...Harold knows how to get open and when he sees things happening on the field he comes back to the huddle and tells me what will work...Charle helps keep things stable, he doesn't let things get too high or too low...We hope he'll be a good stabilizing influence right through the regular season and the playoffs...And besides that he's tall and makes a good target...You saw us almost pull-off a tip-play from Charle to Steve Largent and the end of the first half...We tend to go to the shotgun more with Jim in there, but we won't hesitate to use it with me in there also, we just didn't have to go to it in the second half...
