49ers won the toss (Seahawks calling heads, coin falling tails). 49ers elected to receive. Seattle chose to defend the North goal. Kickoff came at 6:07 pm PDT. Johnson kicked off to Harmon 1 yard deep in the endzone. Harmon returned 24 yards, Boyd making the stop.
